Nature of the Work: Together with the Operator, Operate, monitor, maintain, and trouble-shoot the wastewater treatment facility, irrigation system, collection system and its processes. Work involves responsibility for the technical aspects of plant operations, in compliance with DEQ permit operating regulations, and collection sewer system. Work is performed under the direction of the Operator.

## Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Assist with all sampling, monitoring and testing required to maintain compliance with DEQ permits and Local regulations governing the wastewater treatment and irrigation process. Generate information for use in the Operator's annual report for DEQ.
- Assist with the installation and inspection of new sewer lines and new services. Including meeting with owners and contractors setting, location and hookup of new septic tanks and installing pumps.
- Assist with ordering pumps chemicals and supplies.
- Assist with keeping irrigation area cleared of fallen trees, regular weed control.
- Assist with regular and unscheduled maintenance and repairs on all plant equipment and machinery, including irrigation system and sprinkler heads. During irrigation season change laterals and testing daily.
- Assist with pumping and checking of lift stations and residential/business septic tanks and pumps regularly.
- On call to respond to any emergencies and breakdowns at the plant, pump stations and residential homes and business.
- Assist with keeping roads and lagoon plowed and accessible in winter
- Work toward obtaining the following licenses: class 2 Wastewater Treatment Operators, Class 2 Collection, and Land application license.
- Assist the Operator with working with DEQ, Engineers, contractors, homeowners.
